








Fig. 1. Normalised power dissipation.
 $PD\% = 100 \cdot P_D/P_{D\ 25^\circ\text{C}} = f(T_{sp})$




Fig. 3. Safe operating area. $T_{sp} = 25^\circ\text{C}$
 I_D & $I_{DM} = f(V_{DS})$; I_{DM} single pulse; parameter t_p




Fig. 2. Normalised continuous drain current.




Fig. 4. Transient thermal impedance.




Fig.5. Typical output characteristics, $T_j = 25^\circ C$.
 $I_D = f(V_{DS})$; parameter V_{GS}




Fig.8. Typical transconductance, $T_j = 25^\circ C$.
 $g_{fs} = f(I_D)$; parameter T_j




Fig.6. Typical on-state resistance, $T_j = 25^\circ C$.
 $R_{DS(ON)} = f(I_D)$; parameter V_{GS}




Fig.9. Normalised drain-source on-state resistance.
 $a = R_{DS(ON)}/R_{DS(ON)25^\circ C} = f(T_j)$




Fig.7. Typical transfer characteristics.
 $I_D = f(V_{GS})$; parameter T_j




Fig.10. Gate threshold voltage.
 $V_{GS(TO)} = f(T_j)$; conditions: $I_D = 1 \text{ mA}$; $V_{DS} = V_{GS}$

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


Fig.11. Sub-threshold drain current.
 $I_D = f(V_{GS})$; conditions: $T_j = 25^\circ\text{C}$; $V_{DS} = V_{GS}$




Fig.14. Typical reverse diode current.
 $I_F = f(V_{DS})$; conditions: $V_{GS} = 0 \text{ V}$; parameter T_j




Fig.12. Typical capacitances, C_{iss} , C_{oss} , C_{rss} .
 $C = f(V_{DS})$; conditions: $V_{GS} = 0 \text{ V}$; $f = 1 \text{ MHz}$




Fig.15. Maximum permissible non-repetitive

 unclamped inductive load





Fig.13. Typical turn-on gate-charge characteristics.




Fig.17. SOT223 surface mounting package.
